

## How to set up for using Office365

The following instructions can be used to set up KeyesMail to use Office365 as your mail server. Please be aware that Office365 has different rules that you must follow, or they will not accept your email. These instructions will show you how to get it working properly.

We recommend that you use KeyesMail Version 10.3 or higher to connect with Office365. You can find your version using the following command:

```
KMVERSION
```

The following instructions will require that you have enough authority to be able to access the operating system. We recommend that you sign on with a User Profile that has \*SECADM authority.

### Step 01 Download the “How to create an SSL Application for KeyesMail” instructions.

Follow those instructions to create the SSL Application. This is needed in order to be able to connect to the mail server using TLS (Transport Layer Security) which Office365 requires.

### Step 02 Setup the Mailbox correctly

Using item 31 (User Setup) from KMMENU, you must enter the mailaccount that you create in the Office365 system:

```
Type choices, press Enter.
Name . . . . . : Your Company Name
Department . . . . . :
Return address . . . . . : mailaccount@yourdomain.com
```

This will be the Return Address that will be used for all email that you send through Office365.

## Step 03 Set up the Mail Connection to Office365

Using item 21 (KeyesMail Connections) from KMMENU, you must set up the following parameters for Office365:

Set your domain to the part of the mail account that is to the right of the @ character. Set the SMTP Server and POP3 Server addresses, as follows:

```
Text description 'use quotes' > Office365
Organization/'Company name' . . . > 'Your Company Name'
Connection type . . . . . > I Dialup/Intranet/Continuous
Time zone . . . . . > *SYS *SYS, EST, CST, ..., UT, -0500
Domain name 'use quotes' > 'your-domain.com'

SMTP Server 'Name' or Address . > smtp.office365.com

POP3 Server 'Name' or Address . > outlook.office365.com
```

The POP3 Server address should be left blank if you are not going to receive email from the Office365 account into KeyesMail. To clear a value, enter ' ' and press Enter.

Set the SMTP Authentication parameter with the mail account that you created in Office365. It must match the Return Address from Step 2, above.

```
SMTP Authentication:
User/Account 'use quotes' > 'mailaccount@yourdomain.com'
Password 'use quotes' > 'pasSword'
```

The Password must be entered within quotes and is case-sensitive. Make sure that you do not use an exclamation point (!) in the password. It will not work.

Set the Ports, as follows:

```
SMTP Port (usually 00025) . . . > 00587 Character value
Use SSL/TLS or STARTTLS . . . > S Y=SSL or TLS, S=STARTTLS, N=No
POP3 Port (usually 00110) . . . > 00995 Character value
Use SSL Secure Connection . . . > Y Y/N
```

Set the following maximum amounts, unless you find that Office365 can go bigger than these values:

```
Max mail size Transmitted . . . > 020 001-999 MBytes, 999=No Max
Max mail sent per Session . . . > 040 001-999 Pieces, 999=No Max
```

## **Step 04      Setting the Reply-To Address**

Office365 will not allow you to change the From Address for your emails to anything other than what it has recorded for you. The From Address must be set to the account that you created in Office365 or to an Alias address that you add in the Office365 account setup.

Instead of changing the From Address, KeyesMail will allow you to set the Reply-To Address.

```
From: "Your Company Name" <mailaccount@yourdomain.com>
Sender:
Reply-To: reply-to-someone-else@yourdomain.com
Resent-From:
Fill out extra fields only if different than From:
```

The From Address must match the Account or an Alias that you set up in Office365. This value is set from what you code in item 31 (User Setup), from Step 2, above.

You may change the Reply-To Address, in all of the KeyesMail applications to achieve the same results as you used to get when changing the From Address, in the past. When a recipient presses the Reply button, their reply will go to the Reply-To Address, instead of the From Address.

## **End of setting up for Office365**
